Having just returned from a three day mini-vacation, I am pleased to share with you a guest writer for this week's "Let's Talk." Brian King began attending our Church starting on Blue Christmas, which he attended to honor his brother Bobby. Since coming to Galt UMC, Brian has been extremely helpful and generous in advising us about upgrading our sound system. He is a professional dj who brings music to many Galt community events. Here is what he has written for us:



From the January 16 newsletter, you asked for folks to share meaningful songs. In my business, I have thousands that are meaningful to me. Some make me smile, some make me cry, and some really touch my soul. I will share my top 3 with you. The first one I'm sure has universal meaning to lots of people. It is titled "What Might Have Been" and is sung by Little Texas. It ponders the thought of making decisions and asks what might have been if my decision was different. Very profound. Second song is titled "Live Like You Were Dying" by Tim McGraw. It absolutely defines what I personally went through upon my cancer diagnosis. It was as if the song was written just for me! It did provide much needed hope and comfort as I went through the process of chemotherapy and recovery. I know

many cancer patients that also relate to that song. The final song is an absolute miracle. I shared with Pastor Mary about my brother Bobby who was killed at age 19 in Vietnam. He attended Highlands High School, was 6'3" and a football star. He had pro qualities and was being scouted. This song came out in 2009 and is called "Nineteen" by Taylor Hicks. It touched my very soul when I heard it the first time. Again, like it was written specifically for Bobby. Brings me to tears every time I hear it.

What is a Circuit? Electricians have an answer to this. So do Methodists! Within the organization of local Churches, groups of 8-10 Churches are placed together according to geography so that they can

support each other in the mission of MAKING DISCIPLES OF JESUS CHRIST FOR THE TRANSFORMATION OF THE WORLD. Galt UMC is in a Methodist Circuit that includes local Churches in Lodi and Stockton. Pastor Mary attends a Circuit Meeting every month and yearly we will be switching pulpits so Pastors can get to know other Churches in our Circuit better. This coming Sunday is our Circuit Pulpit Switch. As part of our pulpit switch a special offering is declared, and our Sunshine Food Pantry Building Fund was selected to be the recipient for 2023!



John and Charles Wesley, the founders of the Methodist movement were big believers in ACCOUNTABILITY. They understood that people

grow deeper in Christ when they are honest with a small group of people who will receive their confession, pray with them, and help them to open their eyes to the grace of God. For this reason, the Wesley's set up "classes" within each of their worshipping communities that met weekly for the purpose of spiritual support and accountability. While Galt UMC does not have "classes" per say, we do have groups and committees that see each other outside of worship. For example, the people from Galt UMC who volunteer for the food pantry are deeply connected, those who attend Bible Study on Tuesdays, Quilt Club on Mondays, etc. The Prayer Group that Colleen Hurley is offering is another opportunity to build a "class" of people with whom you can grow in Christ.
