When I was traveling in West Africa visiting the homes of Christians from various Churches, the one thing they all had in common were family "altars." Some of these altars were on shelves, other on small tables, yet others on a pillar of bricks or stones especially constructed for such a purpose. Every altar had a cross. Otherwise they were individual in nature, depending on the religious season of the year or the particular prayer needs of the family. Why have a family altar?

For some it was because their Church was too far away to make Sunday worship every week, so family worship focused on the home altar. For others, it gave a place where mid-week prayers and devotions could be focused. When I returned from my travels, I set up a home altar in a corner of my bedroom. It became an important touchstone for my faith, reminding me at a glance of my identity as a follower of Christ. On my altar I had several crosses that had been given to me by beloved friends over the years. I had a special vase, and I would change out cut flowers every few days to honor the Lord. An open Bible and a candle completed my "home sacred space."

This year during Lent I want to invite you to create your own home altar by designating a spot where you can place a cross, a candle, your Bible, and the various objects you will receive every Sunday during Lent. Each object you will receive during Worship has been selected to remind you of an important lesson given to us by the Lord Jesus Christ during Holy Week. The more you pray about and ponder the Eight Days That Changed the World, the more deeply you will be changed into the person Christ has called each of us to be. There is no more important journey in the world, than the one that brings you the gift of God's salvation. Come to worship and receive.



p.s. Those who came to worship on Ash Wednesday have begun their collection of objects with a bit of rough fabric that represents sackcloth. Sackcloth and ashes are the Scriptural representations of grief over having broken the heart of God with our disobedience. If you were not able to be at Ash Wednesday, I invite you to acquire your own bit of burlap or scratchy fabric to represent sackcloth for your first home altar item.

<u>The Work of the Church – How Our</u> <u>Church Works by Pastor Mary</u>

Methodism is the Christianity of GRACE. Every kind of Christianity has its own particular emphasis, and GRACE is ours! John Wesley, our founder, believed that God's grace expresses itself in three ways: 1) <u>before salvation</u> as "the divine love that surrounds all humanity" – this grace is

called Prevenient Grace; 2) in salvation as "a decisive change in the human heart" brought about through the prompting of grace and the guidance of the Holy Spirit - this grace is variously called Born Again, Saved, Conversion, or Justification - it is a new beginning marked by the inward assurance that our sins are forgiven; 3) after salvation as we grow in grace and through the power of the Holy Spirit are "enabled to increased in the knowledge and love of God and in the love for our neighbor" this grace is called Sanctification or Perfection or Holiness. For Wesley, the gift of Christian "perfection" is "having the mind of Christ and walking as He walked." In living lives of holiness we offer hope to the world and can work toward transforming our communities. As The Book of Discipline states: "This gracious gift of God's power and love, the hope and expectation of the faithful, is neither warranted by our efforts nor limited by our frailties." Being complete, whole, and perfected in grace is the desire of every Christian's heart, according to Wesley, and while we can only ever approximate it this side of heaven, it is because of this desire in response to God's grace that we, in partnership with the Holy Spirit, may transform the world. 


Pictorial Directory or Photo Board?
