I have loved every community I've ever served as a Pastor. Some, I've even fallen in love with – imagining that I could put down roots and even retire there. Because I was originally only supposed to serve here for a year (from July 2020-June 2021) I never entertained the idea of falling in love with Galt. As a matter of fact, John and Zola and I never even unpacked most of our boxes until we received the surprising news that I would be staying another year. And that year became a third year, and it looks very likely that I will be

appointed for a fourth year, and perhaps beyond that given our building projects and the growth of the vitality of our beloved Galt UMC.

So..... (drumroll please) I have decided to purchase a home in Galt! My thinking is that I will serve as many more years as your Pastor as I will be granted by the Bishop and Cabinet, and then retire here. The way this will work is that once I have purchased a home, the Board of Trustees will ready the parsonage as a rental. The rent that is collected will cover the property tax, \$500 a month toward a rental maintenance fund, with the balance coming to me as a "housing allowance." (Local Churches are required to provide their pastor housing, which can be accomplished either through providing a parsonage, or through a housing allowance.) My adult children and I are very excited to own our own home again. We are even considering getting a second companion dog for Freya.

<u>The Work of the Church – How Our</u> <u>Church Works by Pastor Mary</u>

My favorite thing to do as a pastor is teach Bible Study classes. I have spent a life time studying Scripture in an attempt to "interpret individual texts in light of their place in the Bible as a whole" as The Book of Discipline of

the United Methodist Church instructs us. When I teach, I feel my faith quickened, my eyes opened, and my understanding clarified. It is always a thrill to watch as a person has an "AHA" moment, putting things together in their own heart and mind in a fresh and meaningful way. Only the Holy Spirit can accomplish that, and I feel like the Holy Spirit uses me as a Bible teacher, even more than as a preacher. The living Christ meets us in Scripture study, especially where two or more are gathered. As much as I may gain in my own individual studies, Christ truly comes alive when I share what I have learned with a group, and as individuals within that group receive that extraordinary experience of redeeming grace. What I love about being a United Methodist is the freedom to ask questions about Scripture, to engage my mind in literary and historical studies that enrich my understanding of Scripture, and to talk about the issues that arise in settings of faith and inquiry. Within Methodism, asking questions about things you don't understand is seen as an act of faith, not as a reflection of doubt!

P.S. I misunderstood something about the Safe Gathering Certificate required to teach Sunday school in the United Methodist Church. I want to correct this.

I have been telling congregation members that any relatives of children attending our Sunday school were not allowed to teach. This is WRONG information.


Relatives CAN teach our children. The "Safe Gathering" restriction states that TWO certified people must teach Sunday school. One certified teacher teaching alone is not allowed. These two teachers MUST NOT BE BLOOD RELATED. Also, a husband and wife who are certified to teach cannot teach together at the same time. They are welcome to teach with another person, not their spouse. These rules must be practiced according to "Safe Gatherings" to prevent child abuse, especially sexual child abuse which is all too present today--even in churches.

I apologize for the confusion and hope we can recruit anyone desiring to earn the certificate and teach our Lord's Lambs. If you would like to be a Sunday school teacher, please contact Pastor Mary at church or Madeline at (209) 400-8795. Thank you. Please join us Sunday,
