


<u>The Work of the Church – How Our</u> <u>Church Works by Pastor Mary</u>

About a decade ago I was invited to meet with the leaders of Galt UMC to come up with a strategy for renewal and growth. What touched my heart – and made me declare that I would love to pastor Galt UMC

someday - was your devotion to serving the community. The clearest expression of that is the Sunshine Food Pantry. When God answered my prayer by sending me here, it became clear that the need for food support among our working poor and senior citizens was going to grow. The dramatic increase of need during the pandemic has not let up in this current economic downturn. Friends, 2023 promises to be a banner year in Galt UMCs impact for good in our community. A process that an "Exploratory Committee" entered over two years ago by leaders at Galt UMC is about to give us 14 units of affordable housing for veterans on our empty lots! And because God gives us more than we can ask for or imagine (Ephesians 3:20-21) our project is giving birth to affordable housing units for seniors at two other sites in Galt: the empty lot across the street from Brewster's and the old Sego Milk Plant property at 3rd and F Streets. Christian Church Homes, a non-profit developer of affordable housing is in negotiation for these properties. We hope to hear that this housing project is a GO from all involved parties by the end of this month! Once Christian Church Homes buys our lots, that will put \$180,000 toward the construction of a freestanding Sunshine Food Pantry on the lot the Church Offices, the shed, and the storage container are currently on. More on this next week.
