I remember his name being spoken in hushed tones. His name was often accompanied by my aunt's tears, or the sad slow shaking of my uncle's head back and forth as he looked without seeing into the mid-distance. My uncle had lost his best friend in the Vietnam War. There had been a whole group of friends in high school who married one another, started businesses together, moved into neighborhoods near each other, but always there was this missing piece – this missing person – who had been lost to them in a place and in a way that none of them could quite take in, even decades after his death. Others in their group had served in Vietnam too, and had come home, rarely speaking of what they had

experienced or done. What I mostly remember about my uncle is that when he would drink, he always drank too much, and when he drank too much that is when he would speak his friend's name in a grave, hushed way that had me refrain from asking the hundred and one questions that I usually peppered my favorite uncle with. As I have come to know you more deeply, I am aware that a number of you also have names that you speak in hushed tones: fathers and husbands and brothers and sons and cousins and friends who have died while serving our country. (Women die too in the service of our country, though I am not aware that any of you have lost a female loved one in war.) You are in my prayers this weekend. The names you speak in hushed

Many thanks to the 21 people who came to the Roundtable Discussion regarding the split in the United Methodist Church regarding human sexuality. Your Lay Member to Annual Conference Mercedes Diego and Pastor Mary plan to convene another round table in the coming months once more information is available regarding the scale of disaffiliation in our As Pastor Mary reported, only six denomination. Churches have decided to leave the UMC in the California-Nevada Conference. She also hopes to have more information that she can share regarding Bishop Carcano's ongoing suspension and anticipated ecclesiastical trial the next time we meet for a Roundtable Discussion. In the meantime, please keep our Bishop, as well as those who have brought charges against her, in your prayers. Bishop Carcano issued the following public statement: While I regret that my complaint process has reached the place of an expected trial, I continue to have faith in our disciplinary procedures, and even greater faith in our God who does bring forth light in moments of darkness and healing in brokenness. I am in prayer for a trial process that is led by our United Methodist commitment to fairness and justice.


