

This time of year always reminds me of that well known Scripture from Ecclesiastes: *For everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under heaven: a time to be born and a time to die.* This time 26 years ago I was pregnant with my first child, John. We were past the “danger zone” of pregnancy and I was feeling pretty good. We were living in Sergeantsville, New Jersey at the time, near the Delaware River and I spent the whole of that fall walking the hills of our town, trying to maintain my weight and vitality as the due date drew near. The fall foliage was magnificent, getting more brilliant as the days went on, reflecting my outlook on life. A new life! A new chapter of marriage! A new name “MOM” for me! Fall reminds me of that season. But fall also reminds me of my husband’s final illness. He died this time of year. This time 19 years ago we were living in Cameron Park with our children John and Zola. Boikanyo became increasingly ill as the days got shorter, the weather got cooler, and the leaves started to change. That fall I was more aware of the leaves that fell from the trees, than the ones that clung to their branches. I remember standing on the front porch of the house, several weeks before Boikanyo died, watching the children play in the front yard. They would build up piles of yellow and brown fallen leaves as high as they could, then run into the pile, leaves flying everywhere. I remember crying softly as I watched them play. This year, as soon as the leaves started to turn, I felt this overwhelming gratitude for all of life. For beginnings. For endings. For the whole precious journey. The changing leaves are reminding me to be grateful for every season of life.




Our TOTAL GIVING for the General Fund - January 1, 2022, thru September 25, 2022 is: \$129,947.16!!



The Work of the Church – How Our Church Works

The “appointment” system is probably the hardest thing for United Methodists to explain to friends from other Churches. It developed two hundred years ago when there were lots of Methodists and only a few ordained Pastors. Pastors would ride their horses around a “circuit” of Churches to baptize, marry, bury, and officiate Holy Communion. Most Churches only saw their Circuit Riding Pastor quarterly, which meant most of the preaching, teaching, and administration was done by the “laity” as non-clergy are called in the Methodist Church. This worked well for over a hundred years, as Methodists caught the Spirit and enthusiastically proclaimed the Gospel in their communities, often building schools and hospitals as an expression of love for God and their neighbors. As there began to be more Methodists who felt called to the ministry, pastors were able to take up residence in a community. However, our Methodist organization still considers the members of the Church to be more important in the life of the Church than the pastors appointed there. Pastors are considered to be, more or less, interchangeable. It is up to the members of the Staff Parish Relations Committee to communicate with the District Superintendent as to whether their Church is best served by a different pastor, or by reappointing the same one. Every year these forms are turned in by December 1st for decision making on the part of the Bishop and District Superintendents for who will serve what local Church starting on July 1st. Pastors also turn in their own forms on December 1st and check one of three boxes: I wish to stay at my current appointment; I wish to be moved to a new appointment; I am open to either staying or leaving. Spoiler alert: I am asking to stay at Galt UMC! Next week a word about Bishops and District Superintendents and how they are selected.
