<u>The Work of the Church – How</u> Our Church Works

The Board of Trustees takes faithful care of the physical properties owned by our Church. This past year they organized repairs of the dry rot on the parsonage, a home owned by Galt UMC for the appointed pastor to live in, as well as the re-sealing of the parking lot. Our Trustees also care for the landscaping around

our Sanctuary building and office, as well as repairing anything that goes wrong with plumbing, electrical, etc. Other important matters that fall under the Trustees include fire inspections and insurance coverage. Currently the Board of Trustees is working on readying a classroom upstairs for our Sunday School, as well as a more organized space in an adjacent room upstairs for us to store our worship decorative items. It's a big job and we have been blessed with hard-working trustees. Might you consider being appointed to the Board of Trustees for a three year term starting January There are two aspects of the Board of Trustees that make it different than other committees: up to a third of the members do not have to be members of our Church AND the Board itself elects its own Chair at the January meeting.
